Anando Mukerjee is “India's finest tenor” (The Statesman, 2009) and enjoys an international career. He studied singing privately in the UK after reading Natural Sciences at Cambridge University and with the legendary Nicolai Gedda, one of the 20th Century's greatest tenors.

An Italianate spinto tenor specialising in Bel-canto, Romantic and Verismo Italian and French opera and most recently the Wagnerian heldentenor repertoire. He has a large and diverse concert repertoire encompassing oratorio and art-song being a keen recitalist in seven languages from the Baroque to the Modern eras.

He has appeared at the Kennedy Center, Royal Opera House (Crush Room), Royal Albert Hall, Scottish Opera, Belgrade National Opera, Longborough Festival Opera, the National Centre for the Performing Arts (Bombay), Cadogan Hall & Wigmore Hall.

He was a finalist in the 2012 Wagner Society Bayreuth Bursary Competition and has been regularly featured on the BBC (World Service & Radio 3 In-Tune), Premier Christian Radio & All-India Radio.
